Trunk OR Treat Information Packet

Trunk or Treat is a fun, safe alternative to nighttime trick or treating, as it occurs in daylight hours. You have been invited to decorate the trunk of your car, golf cart, truck bed, or the back of your S.U.V. and hand out candy and other goodies to the people of Kentucky who will be dressed in their spookiest or silliest Halloween costumes and will walk from trunk to trunk to see what treats are to be had.

If you are new to Trunk-or-Treat, it is an event where volunteers decorate the trunks of their cars and pass out individually wrapped candy to people, some provided by donations from community members. The people walk by the cars and receive candy at each decorated car. It is a great time for people to enjoy the evening and not feel scared, and it is a great opportunity to introduce people to our community!

Trunk or Treat Guidelines

Participating vehicles must be parked in the designated area no later than 1:30 PM (you can come as early as 11:00 AM. As you enter, the parking lot team can help direct you to a spot on the right-side parking lot.

YOU MUST CHECK IN WITH OUR STAFF FIRST!
Safety Comes first!

You are responsible for your setup and Candy! We will try to provide donated candy to you if we receive any.

All participating trunks must be decorated and staffed by 2:00 PM. Vehicles arriving after 1:30 PM will not be allowed to participate for safety reasons. Trunk-or-treating begins at 2:00 PM. To ensure safety, participating vehicles must remain parked until the event ends and the participants have vacated the area (by approximately 5:30 PM).

Open and decorate your trunk or the back of your vehicle. There is some excellent trunk decorating ideas on the web; you can even buy kits in stores now!

Not interested in decorating your car but want to join us and hand out candy? Great! Bring your candy and lawn chairs, and we'll park you between the cars.

Possibilities could include a Halloween theme, sports, comic characters, exotic locations, or a particular decade- and can be as elaborate or simple as you wish. If lights are needed, please ensure they're battery-powered, ***as electricity will not be available on site.*** We welcome you to wear a costume.

Bring some lawn chairs to sit in and hand out candy to everyone! Yes, all ages are allowed to Truck or Treat. We do not limit the age group.

Compliment costumes! Meet a family! Have fun!

For candy, please only bring store-bought individually wrapped treats. Or consider giving out a non-candy pleasure (bubbles, other small prizes). Every year is different, but we expect around 2,000 people to join the Truck or Treat part of HalloQueen. Don't Panic if you run out of candy! We will clarify that this part of the event is while supplies last! We will do everything we can to get candy donations and help!

Trunk or Treat is an alcohol-free event.

This year's event is 3 hours, ending at 5:00 PM; we will close the entry at 4:45 PM.

For safety reasons, you cannot MOVE or Idle your vehicle during the truck or treat! Once everyone has exited the Trunk or Treat Path, you may break down your decorations; for your time, we will provide you with FREE, Entry into HalloQueen, but you must attend the Truck or Treat event the entire time.

IMPORTANT: Some non-food or Food treats may also contain top allergens. Parents and legal guardians —NOT event organizers — are responsible for ensuring their child(ren) 's goodies are safe for their allergies.

Please drop off donations at the guest services window if you want to donate leftover individually wrapped candy after this event. There will be a container at the event for your contributions.
